










GUT FEELINGS


The sculpture is to be placed in public space in such a way that visitors can fully enter the sculpture.

Inside the sculptural resonance body in the form of a cut-open matryoshka, one is immersed in the sound installation. Recorded inner voices speak.

The body of this work is a sculptural echo chamber of different experiences, convictions and considerations that shape us socially, also on the topic of motherhood. The recorded voices are loud and quiet; young and old speak in concise short sentences or in almost overlapping words. in words that almost come to a head, expressing themselves with thoughtfulness or in impulse.















UNBUTTON, 80x100cm, mixed media on canvas, 2022




PORTRAIT ELSIE






GETTING MY TIME
